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**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2017-08**  
**CREATION OF LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICE IN THE**  
**MUNICIPALITY OF GABALDON, NUEVA ECIJA**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Rule IV, Section 26 of the Republic Act 10742 otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Reform Act of 2015 and its implementing Rules and regulations provides for the creation of a Youth Development Office in every province, city and municipality;

**WHEREAS**, this Local Government Unit acknowledges/recognizes the vital role of youth in our society. Likewise, this LGU has a duty to empower our youth, inculcates to them the sense of patriotism, nationalism and other desirable values. Encourages their involvement in public and civic affairs and make sure they have a significant contribution in local governance and in nation building.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant with Section 444 of the Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991 (a) The municipal mayor, as the chief executive of the municipal government, shall exercise such powers and performs such duties and functions as provided by this Code and other laws;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, ROLANDO S. BUE**, Municipal Mayor of Gabaldon, Province of Nueva Ecija, by virtue of power vested in me by existing and applicable laws do hereby order the following;

**SECTION I.** The Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) is hereby created.

**SECTION II.** The Duties and Functions of Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) are the following:

- In accordance with Section 24 (d) of Republic Act 1074, register and verify youth and youth-serving organizations (Subject to the revitalized Youth Organizations' Registration Program (YORP) guidelines);
- Provides technical assistance to the LYDC of the concerned LGU in the formulation of the LYDP;
- Facilitates election of the LYDC representatives;
- Serves as secretariat to the LYDC;
- Conducts mandatory and continuing training of SK officials and LYDC members, in accordance with the programs jointly designed and implemented by the Commission and the DILG. The local youth development officer and/or his or her staff shall apply for accreditation from the Commission in order for them to conduct the mandatory and continuing training programs of SK officials and LYDC members. In the absence of a Youth Development Office in the province, city or municipality, the designated existing personnel by the LCE shall apply for accreditation with the Commission in order for said official to conduct the mandatory and continuing training programs of SK officials and LYDC members.
- Provides technical, logistical and other support in the conduct of the mandatory and continuing training programs, and to such other programs of the Commission and DILG;
- Coordinates with the Commission, with regard to the youth programs within their jurisdiction; and
- Performs such other functions as may be prescribed by law, ordinance, or as the LCE, the DILG or the Commission may require.

**SECTION III . *Separability Clause.*** – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Executive Order shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION IV. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive order shall take effect immediately.
