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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2019-06
REORGANIZING MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION
AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121 otherwise known as the "**Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010**" mandates all Local Government Units to create Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council;

WHEREAS, this Local Government Unit has a previous composition of MDRRMC and there is an urgent need to reorganize the same due to the changes in the leadership of our municipal government brought about by recent national and local election as well as, due to the transfer of work assignment of other members who are heads of other agencies or departments. Also, the reorganization shall make the MDRRMC more effective and proficient in dispensing its duties and functions to the citizenry of Gabaldon Nueva Ecija for the prevention and reduction of the possible effect of natural and man-made disasters and providing supports and aids to all citizen during the time of adversity;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JOBBY PETINES EMATA, Municipal Mayor of Gabaldon, Province of Nueva Ecija by virtue of power vested in me by existing and applicable laws do hereby order the Reorganization of Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council to wit;

Section II. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The MDRRMC shall have the following functions:

- (1) Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the MDRRMP and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- (2) Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;

- (3) Recommend the implementation of forced or preemptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
- (4) Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as necessary.

Section IV. Duties and Functions. The MDRRMC shall perform the following functions with impartiality given the emerging challenges brought by disasters of our times:

- (1) Design, program, and coordinate disaster risk reduction and management activities consistent with the National Council's standards and guidelines;
- (2) Facilitate and support risk assessments and contingency planning activities at the local level;
- (3) Consolidate local disaster risk information which includes natural hazards, vulnerabilities, and climate change risks, and maintain a local risk map;
- (4) Organize and conduct training, orientation, and knowledge management activities on disaster risk reduction and management at the local level;
- (5) Operate a multi-hazard early warning system, linked to disaster risk reduction to provide accurate and timely advice to national or local emergency response organizations and to the general public, through diverse mass media, particularly radio, landline communications, and technologies for communication within rural communities;
- (6) Formulate and implement a comprehensive and - integrated MDRRMP in accordance with the national, regional and provincial framework, and policies on disaster risk reduction in close coordination with the Municipal Development Council (MDC);
- (7) Prepare and submit to the local sanggunian through the MDRRMC and the LDC the annual LDRRMO Plan and budget, the proposed programming of the MDRRMF, other dedicated disaster risk reduction and management resources, and other regular funding source/s and budgetary support of the MDRRMO/BDRRMC;
- (8) Conduct continuous disaster monitoring and mobilize instrumentalities and entities of the LGUs, CSOs, private groups and organized volunteers, to utilize their facilities and resources for the protection and preservation of life and properties during emergencies in accordance with existing policies and procedures;
- (9) Identify, assess and manage the hazards vulnerabilities and risks that may occur in their locality;
- (10) Disseminate information and raise public awareness about those hazards. vulnerabilities and risks, their nature, effects, early warning signs and counter-measures;
- (11) Identify and implement cost-effective risk reduction measures/strategies;
- (12) Maintain a database of human resource, equipment, directories, and location of critical infrastructures and their capacities such as hospitals and evacuation centers;
- (13) Develop, strengthen and operational mechanisms for partnership or networking with the private sector, CSOs, and volunteer groups;

- (14) Take all necessary steps on a continuing basis to maintain, provide, or arrange the provision of, or to otherwise make available, suitably-trained and competent personnel for effective civil defense and disaster risk reduction and management in its area;
- (15) Organize, train, equip and supervise the local emergency response teams and the ACDVs, ensuring that humanitarian aid workers are equipped with basic skills to assist mothers to breastfeed;
- (16) Respond to and manage the adverse effects of emergencies and carry out recovery activities in the affected area, ensuring that there is an efficient mechanism for immediate delivery of food, shelter and medical supplies for women and children, endeavor to create a special place where internally-displaced mothers can find help with breastfeeding, feed and care for their babies and give support to each other;
- (17) Within its area, promote and raise public awareness of and compliance with this Act and legislative provisions relevant to the purpose of this Act;
- (18) Serve as the secretariat and executive arm of the MDRRMC;
- (19) Coordinate other disaster risk reduction and management activities;
- (20) Establish linkage/network with other LGUs for disaster risk reduction and emergency response purposes;
- (21) Recommend through the MDRRMC the enactment of local ordinances consistent with the requirements of this Act;
- (22) Implement policies, approved plans and programs of the MDRRMC consistent with the policies and guidelines laid down in this Act;
- (23) Establish a Municipal/Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center;

- (24) Prepare and submit, through the MDRRMC and the MDC, the report on the utilization of the LDRRMF and other dedicated disaster risk reduction and management resources to the local Commission on Audit (COA), copy furnished the regional director of the OCD and the Local Government Operations Officer of the DILG; and
- (25) Act on other matters that may be authorized by the MDRRMC.

Section V. COMPENSATION AND REMUNERATION. The MDRRMC/ MDRRMO shall perform their duties as such without additional compensation or remuneration. Members who are not government officials/employees or not officials or employees of this Local Government Unit will be entitled to necessary travelling or any accidental expenses chargeable against the funds of the Municipal Disaster Risk and Reduction and Management Council and subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

Section VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If any provision of this Executive Order shall be held invalid, the other provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION VII. REPEALLING CLAUSE.

Previous executive orders inconsistent herewith or contrary to the provisions of this EO are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive order shall take effect immediately.
